When I was in high school/college, although Presbyterian, I remember going to a local Lutheran Church for their continuous 3-hour Good Friday Service from noon until 3:00 p.m. One could come and go throughout that time as it was divided into segments, or one could stay the entire three hours. Each segment had singing, prayer, and a meditation with different people being involved in leadership. The end of the service concluded with the pastor carrying the cross lifted high and the congregation sing-ing "Lift High the Cross." That was the most moving part of all. I hope you look forward to Holy Week with great anticipation as well!

Holy Week will be celebrated the last week of March this year. We will have services on Palm Sunday and Easter at the usual times of 10:00 A.M.

Palm Sunday - special music, distribution of palms and parade

Maundy Thursday – Messianic Seder Meal with soup supper prior to the seder beginning at 6:30 p.m. Come enjoy the fellowship with one another around the table, understand our roots, and celebrate Holy Communion.

Good Friday – Tenebrae (service of darkening lights) beginning at 7:00 P.M.

Easter – special music, joyful celebration of Jesus' resurrection! Continental breakfast prior to worship in the parlor.

I hope you make every effort to be in worship for each of these services during Holy Week as we draw close to the cross of Christ and all that Jesus did for us by dying for our sins. Celebrate with great joy on Easter morning as we rejoice in the resurrection, knowing through faith in Jesus we can live as free, redeemed people and with hope of the assurance of our eternal home with the Lord.


