

MONDAY NIGHT PRAYER AND BIBLE STUDY meets on Mondays but continues on break during the cold winter months of February.



The Clean Kid's Project Kicks off...

From the local Clothes Closet which works with the Mennonite Central Committee, we have cloth bags to be filled with hygiene items and then returned to the Clothes Closet and they do the shipping and delivery.

The specific items needed for the kits are:

- 1 adult-size toothbrush (in manufacturer's packaging)
- 1 large bar bath soap (leave in wrapper)
- 1 nail clipper (good quality)
- 1 hand towel (medium weight, dark or bright colors; approx. 16 in x 26 in)
- 1 wide-toothed comb (6-8 in)

Thank you for limiting your generosity to the items listed. Due to strict regulations some countries have on the expiration date of toothpaste, MCC no longer asks for toothpaste to be donated with the kits. Instead, we will provide toothpaste with the kits when they ship from our warehouse. Donation Cards for needed items are now on the clothesline in the parlor. Please return your donations by **Sunday, March 15** There are donation tubs in the parlor. Let's team together to do the Lord's work.

From the website, Keeping clean is an important part of remaining healthy, but families who have fled their homes because of disaster or war often struggle to afford these necessary supplies. Hygiene kits also are given through schools or orphanages to encourage healthy habits for children. 69,375 hygiene kits shipped last year to Jordan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Haiti, Democratic Republic of Korea (North Korea), Ukraine, Iraq, Zambia, Lebanon, Burkina Faso, Canada, and the U.S




LIGHT- Learning in God's House Together


