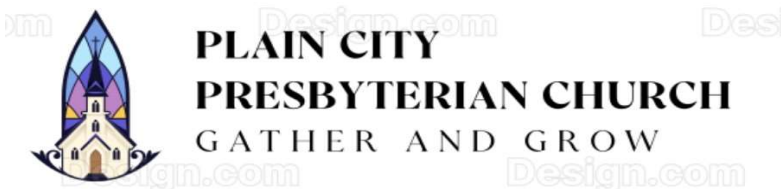

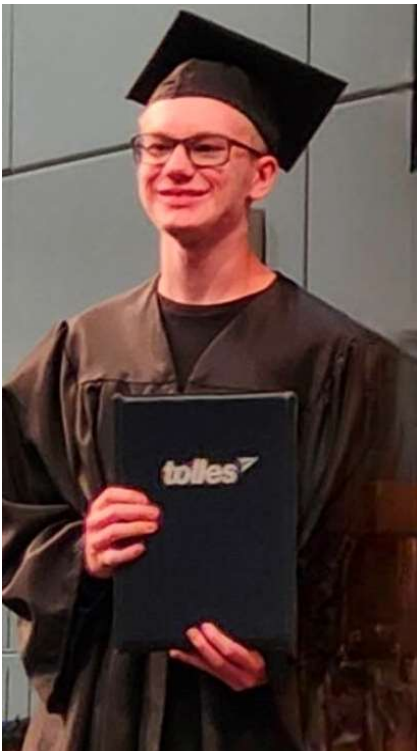
GRADUATE SUNDAY JUNE 7TH
